S: The latest I have is there is a full scale battle along the canal with the Egyptians trying to cross in our direction. They have bombed various places in Sinai. The story about a naval battle is a cover-up for their action.

K: Right. I need as many facts as you can give me on the naval battle even if it did not take place. I am quite persuaded, Mr. Minister. I know whatever actions you take will not happen because of their attack, if that is an Arab charge to cover their action. It is clear the dominant action is in the Canal and along the Golan Heights. We would appreciate as much information as possible.

S: I am passing all along that I get. I will pass it directly to you.

K: Good. I have not decided whether to stay up here or go to Washington. I will probably go to Washington during the day. You will be kept informed.
