K: Good afternoon. We have now decided to go ahead long the lines we discussed earlier. Therefore, you mustn't do anything The President., not the President himself but Key Biscayne, is going to announce that we will ask for a meeting of the Security Council. We will then, around 5:30, ask the President of the Security Council for a meeting tomorrow. We will let it go at that for tonight. We will not indicate today whether we will table a resolution or what it will be. Don't want to get too much generated. We will table a resolution along , this is for your private information, lines we discussed. I understand you will have to speak before the Council.

E: I will have to speak very early.

K: At the Council. . . we will count on your eloquence. . . and in this case wouldn't mind if you sacrificed eloquence to length.

E: Oh, yes, I agree it often happens in inverse relation. I'll just say we want. cease fire in full.

K: Not necessary for you to make any proposal as long as you discuss the situation in great detail.

E: saying Egypt and Syria encroached on us and not us on them. I assure you we are keeping an eye on other Western Europeans, presume you are doing so as well.
