D: I have one or two items I thought I should call to your attention. The Soviets are definitely involved in the Syrian operation. We know of a number of advisers in a regiment as well as in the brigade. In one case, although the adviser not one of. . . took charge of brigade and commanded (perhaps at his own initiative) it. I thought that should be brought to your attention.

K: I will make a strong protest to Dobrynin in the morning.

D: We have taken Kenetik (sp. ?) back. The third item is that so far we've lost 35 planes.

K: Of what type?

D: I don't have the breakdown, but mostly skyhawk.

K:

D: I have another item. After I talked to you our people went to make the arrangements. They had difficulty with Where we had a plane ready to take the. . . they wouldn't let the plane land at any of the airbases.

K: That's nonsense. We had it all arranged.

D: we hire an American plane and fly it to Israel. . . . to land one of our planes there and pick it up.

K: Oh, those God Damn idiots.

D: Should we do anything?

K: Its awfully late if you want to do it tonight.

D: Our boys are now working on chartering a plane to fly to Israel. If get decision reversed. . .

K: Why don't you keep the plane here for some of the ammunition tomorrow.

D: Alright. Our boys will work on the charter.
