Sunday, February 21.

The President's at Camp David, spent the whole day up there. Worked with Safire for a while on the revise of the State of the World. He called me once, mainly to discuss the State of the World plans. He's agreed to Safire's idea of doing a fireside chat, but also agreed to Ziegler's feeling that it shouldn't be hoked up as far as Safire wanted to by doing it in the Domes-- Diplomatic Reception Room, but rather should be done at some other location, probably the EOB. He then discussed again the general schedule plans for press conferences and TV appearances and agreed to the basic plan we had settled on yesterday.
