As you can see from the notes on your memo (attached), the RN quotes should be retained and the signature should be moved up underneath. Something should be done to set it apart from the wording of the award presentation and then Dole could sign the Award. This would put both of the signatures on the certificate as well as the Presidential Seal, and yet have it come from the RNC.

The key thing is to set the quotation apart from the rest of the wording, and this can be done either by outlining one or both of the sets of remarks or changing the print style and size.
